

## Implementation Report regarding the Eardisley Group Plan

To deliver the NP, the PC is going to have to change. This was stated well before the PC decided to do a Plan. The time has now come to make the PC fit to deliver a Plan

There will be jobs to be done on a regular basis to:

- Research the best ways of delivering the policies in the Plan and setting appropriate actions in motion
- Monitor the effects of each phase of development in order to adjust the next actions that should take place

Working Groups composed of parish councillors and residents will have to be set up for each major area of the Plan, e.g. traffic, housing, employment, etc.

Working Groups will report progress and seek agreement for actions at every PC meeting.

Parish Councillors will have to take part in Working Groups and carry out activities between meetings. Where councillors lack the skills to fulfil these functions, training will need to be undertaken.

It will probably be necessary for the PC to meet monthly.
